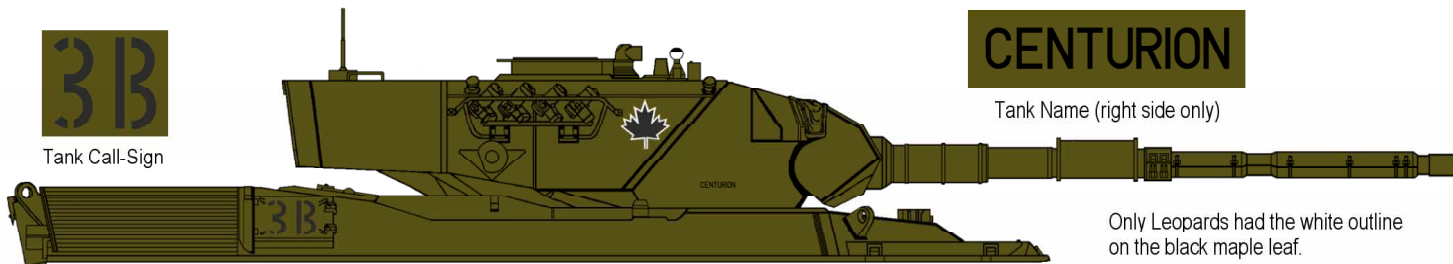

Tank Call-Sign

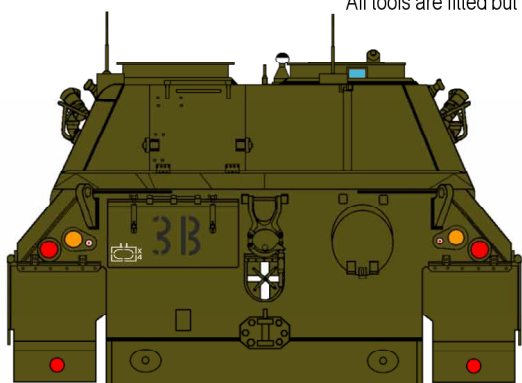


**CENTURION**

Only Leopards had the white outline on the black maple leaf.

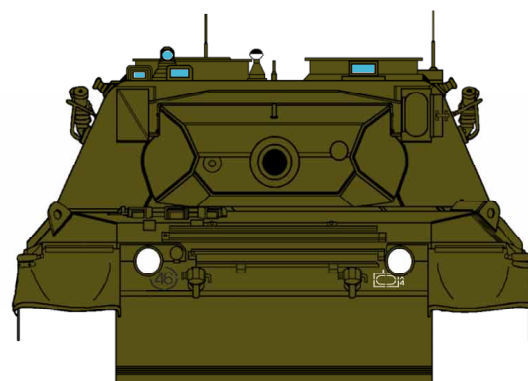
All tools are fitted but not shown.

Bridge Class Sign

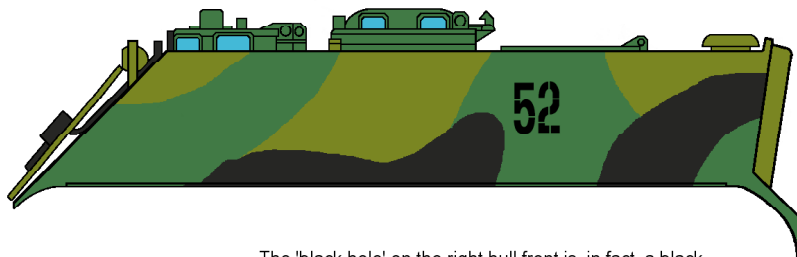


## M113A1 - 2nd Battalion, The Princess Patricia's Canadian Light Infantry, Baden Solingen, West Germany, Sept 1986

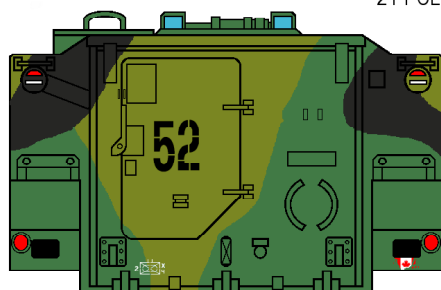
This vehicle is clean but extremely worn with metal showing here and there and signs of overpainted patches.



2 PPCLI Tactical Sign



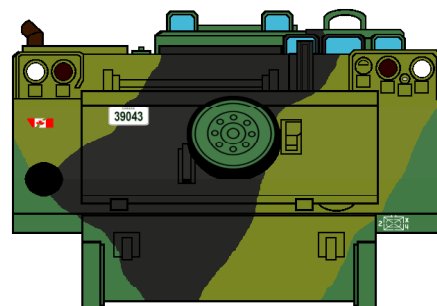
The 'black hole' on the right hull front is, in fact, a black hole...OK, it's a painted black circle...picky, picky...



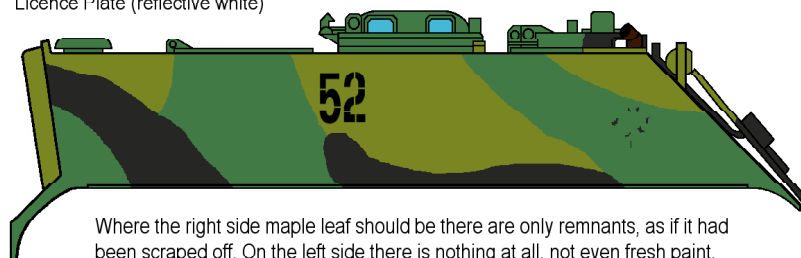
Vehicle Call-Sign
