

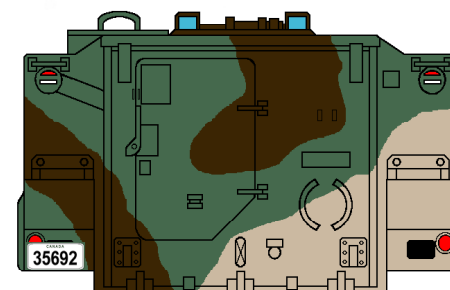
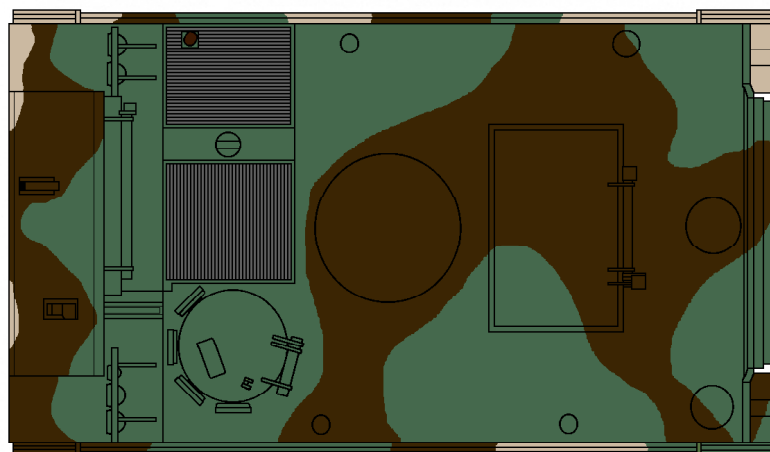
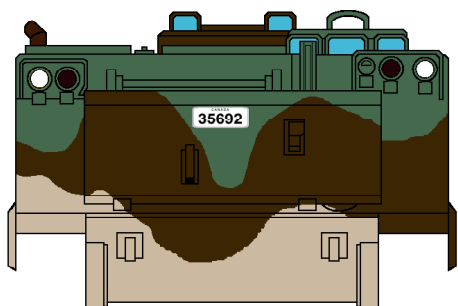
CANADIAN VEHICLE MARKINGS:

A look at the markings, colour schemes and vehicles of the Canadian Army.

This vehicle is shown as it was for the Change of Command parade in the fall of 1969. The vehicle had been specially painted for the event and when on parade the olive paint was still not dry. The three colours are the standard of the day but the camouflage pattern was definitely non-standard. The basic vehicle had been olive over all, hence the olive lower hull.
