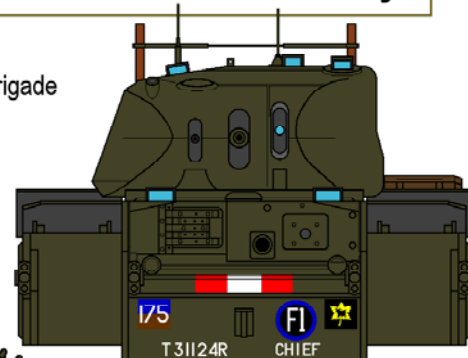
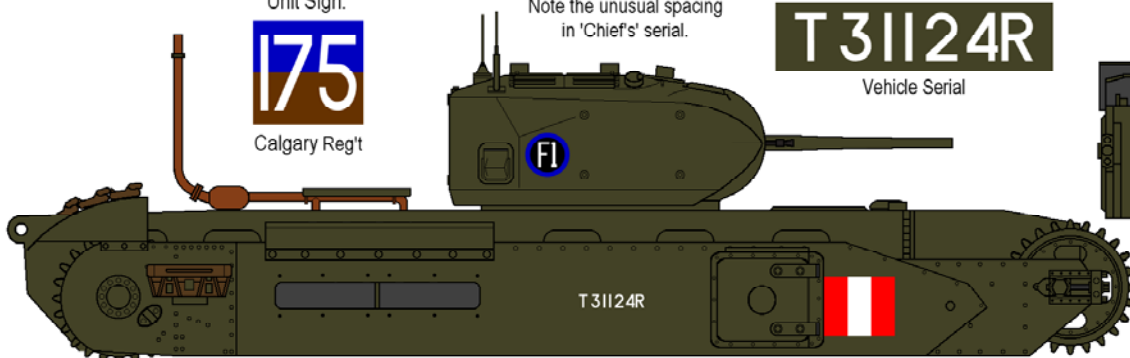

'Chief' is shown as it appeared after being taken into German hands, whether the air intakes were lost on the beach or removed afterwards I do not know.

'Chief' was fitted with the necessary mounting for laying a chespaling carpet but did not carry the carpeting onto the beach.

The remnants of the deep wading waterproofing are not shown in this drawing but it covered all joints, seams and openings.

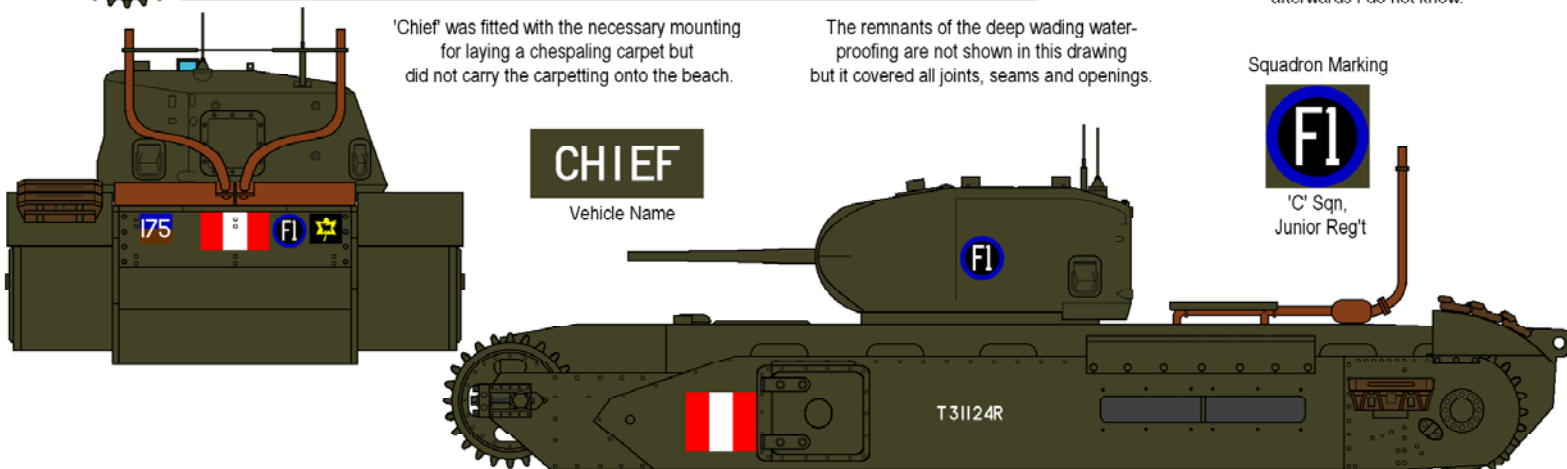

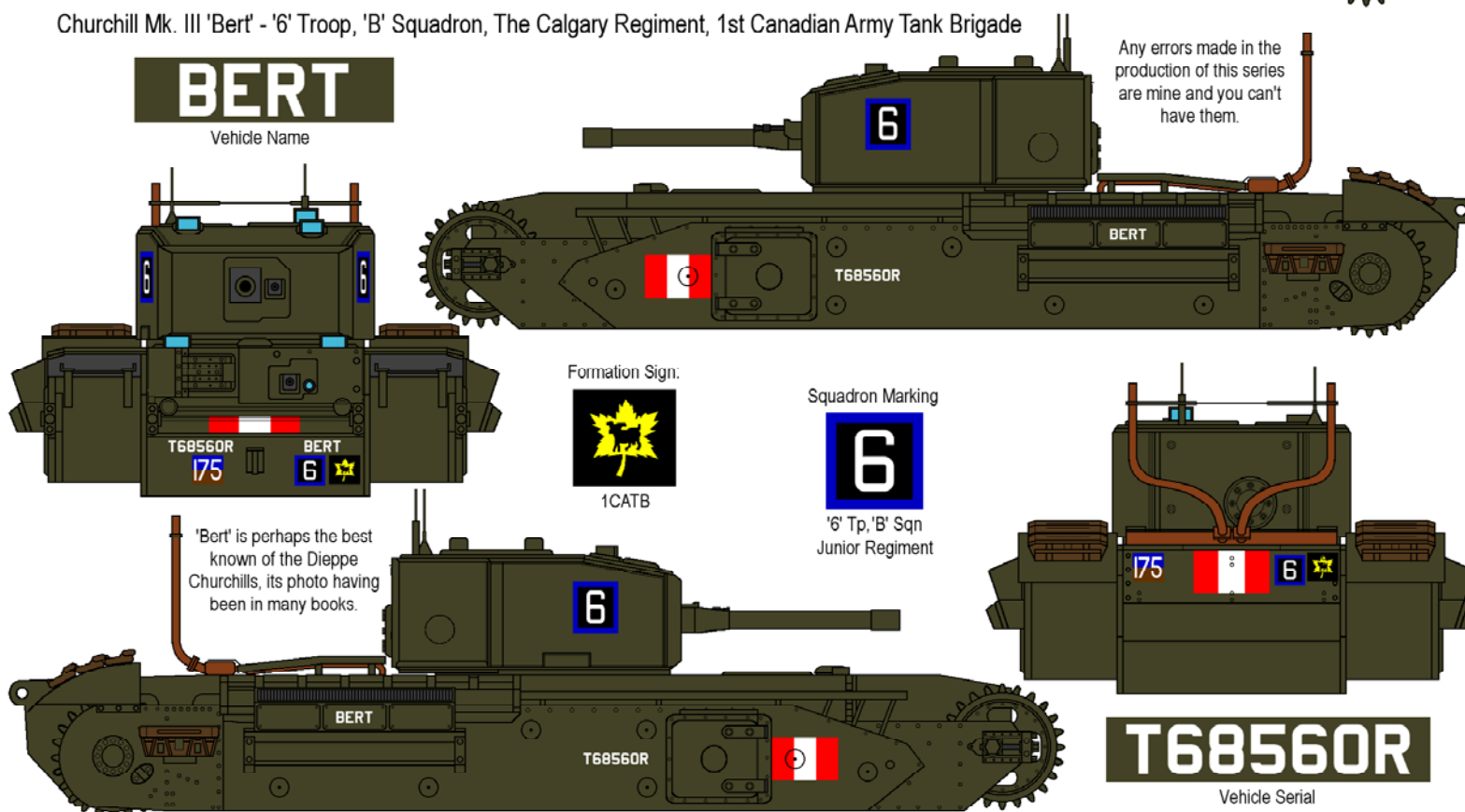

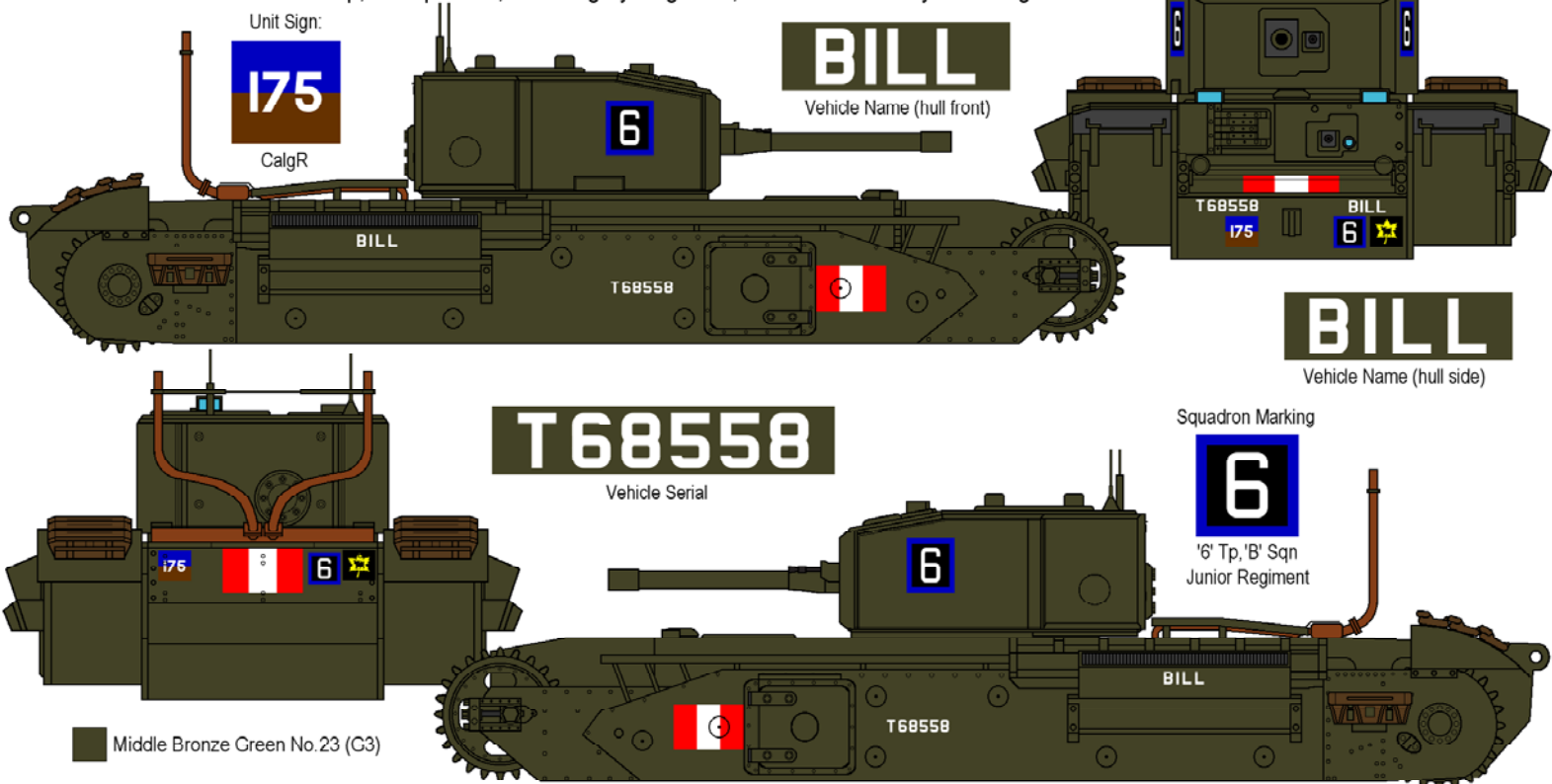
