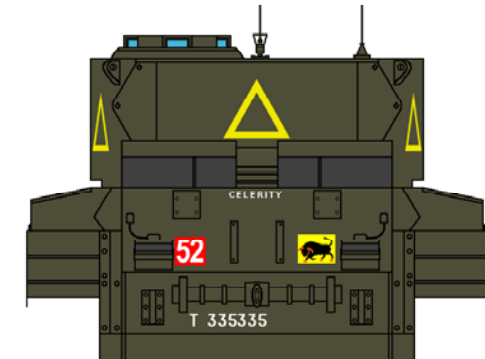
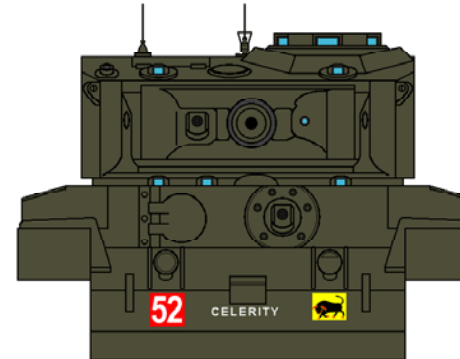
Front and side markings are taken from a photograph, rear markings are a gross estimation and I should be ashamed for doing it.

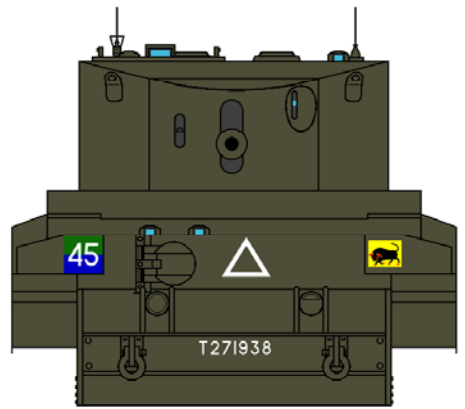
