This vehicle has part of the air recognition turret-top marking, the right side only.

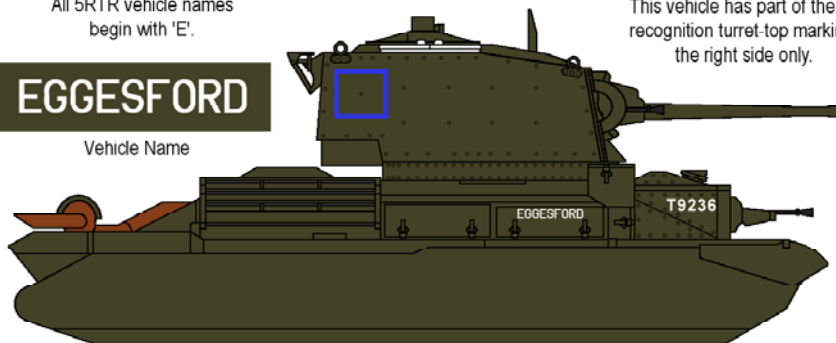

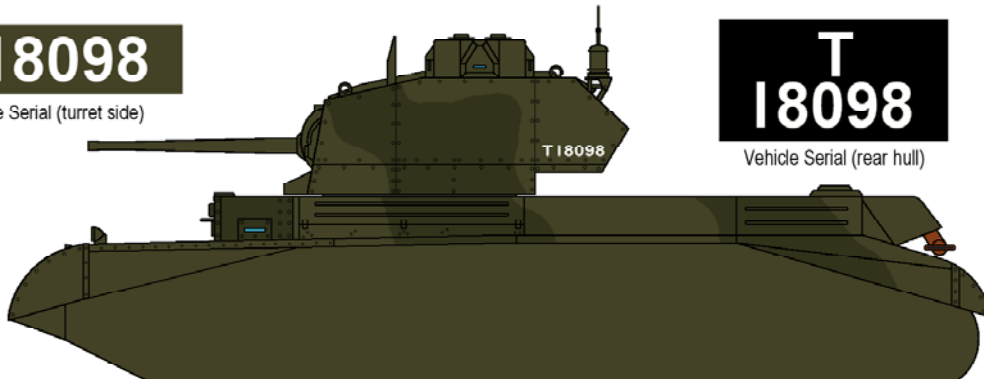
