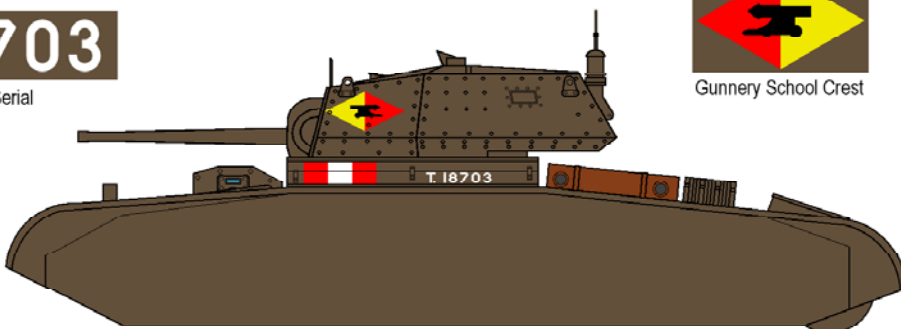

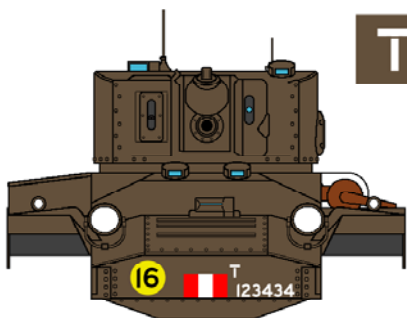

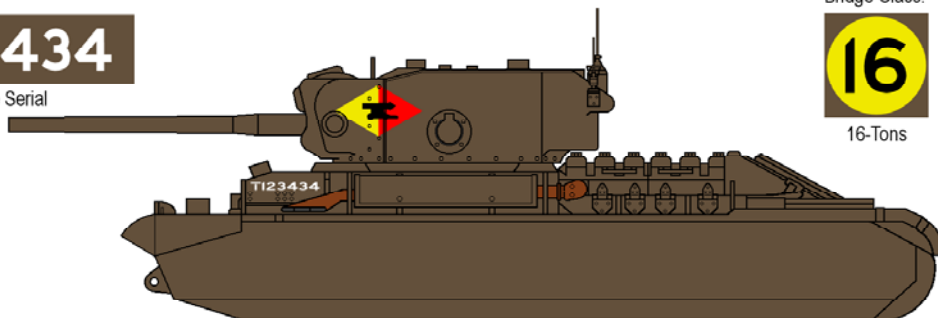
Gunnery School Crest

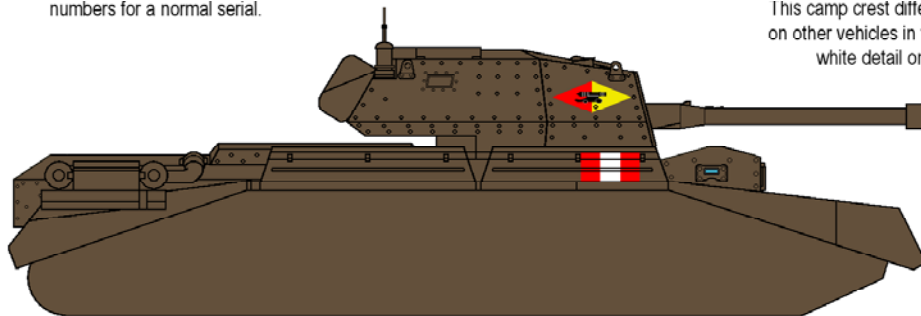

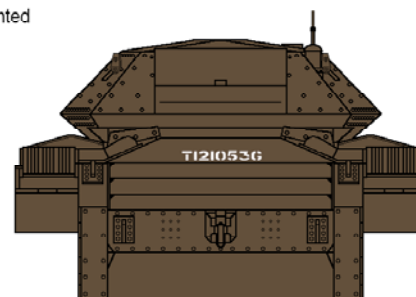


Gunnery School Crest

As with many vehicles 'visiting' the school, the crest was only on one side of the turret and all identifiers were removed.



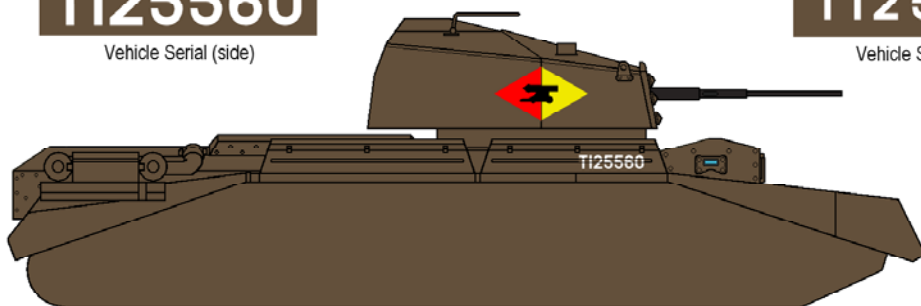
This camp crest differs from those seen on other vehicles in that it has accented white detail on the cannon.
