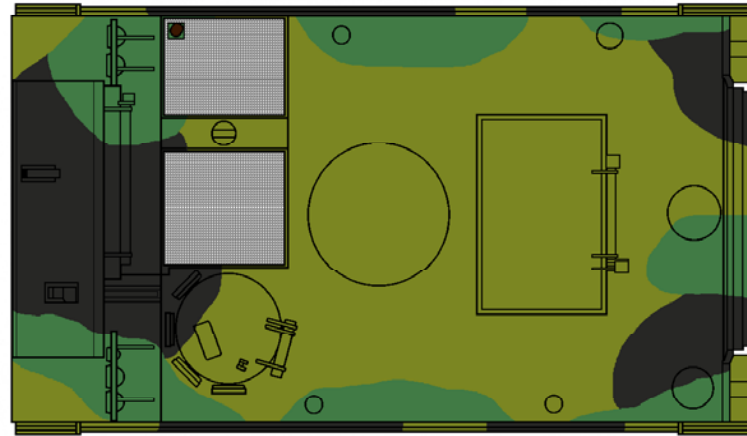
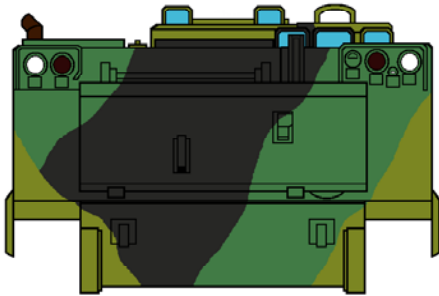
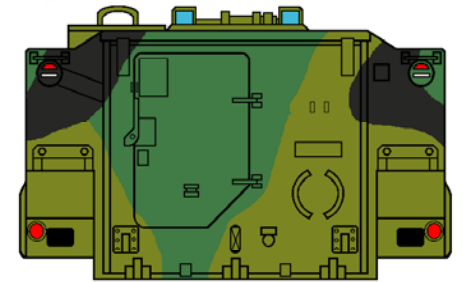


Canadian M113A1 - Domestic Pattern

- FS34172 Green

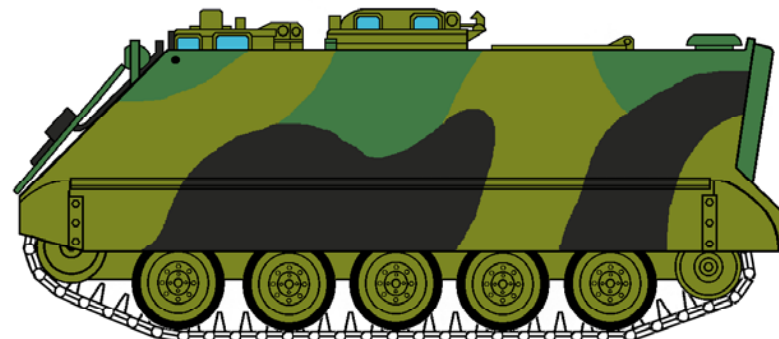
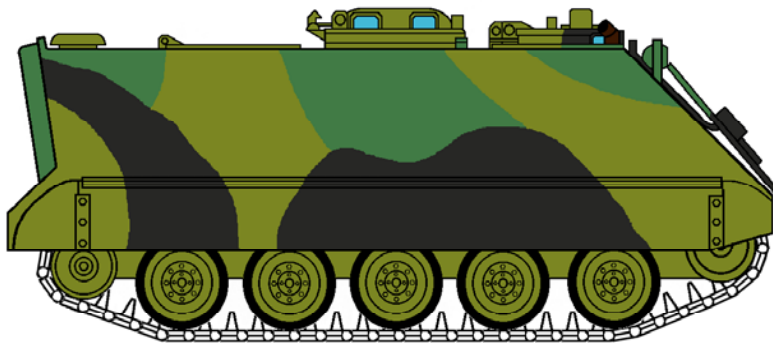


Before 1993 (when 4 C.M.B.G. was returned to Canada and its equipment distributed to the other brigades) it was not usual to see the black maple leaf on domestic-based armoured vehicles.



Note: this is a pattern only, showing new paint colours. Every vehicle could, and usually did, have a variation in pattern from trivial to major. All three colours faded very quickly and were

drastically altered by dirt and dust. The older and more faded the green became, the more it tinted blue. The khaki merely lightened and the black faded. Touch-ups were frequent and very obvious.
