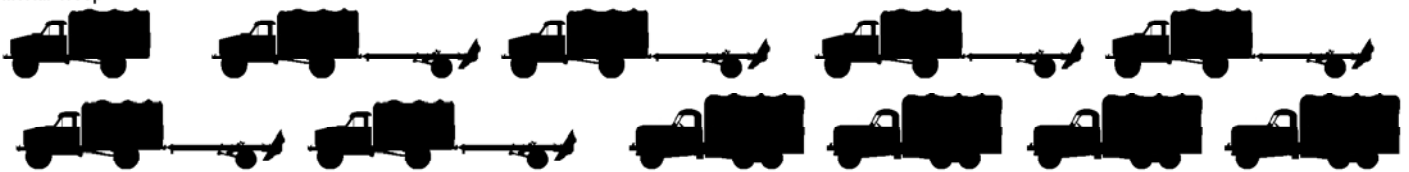


160mm Mortar Battery

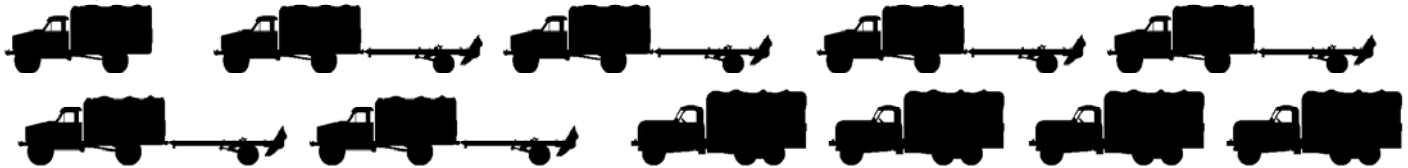

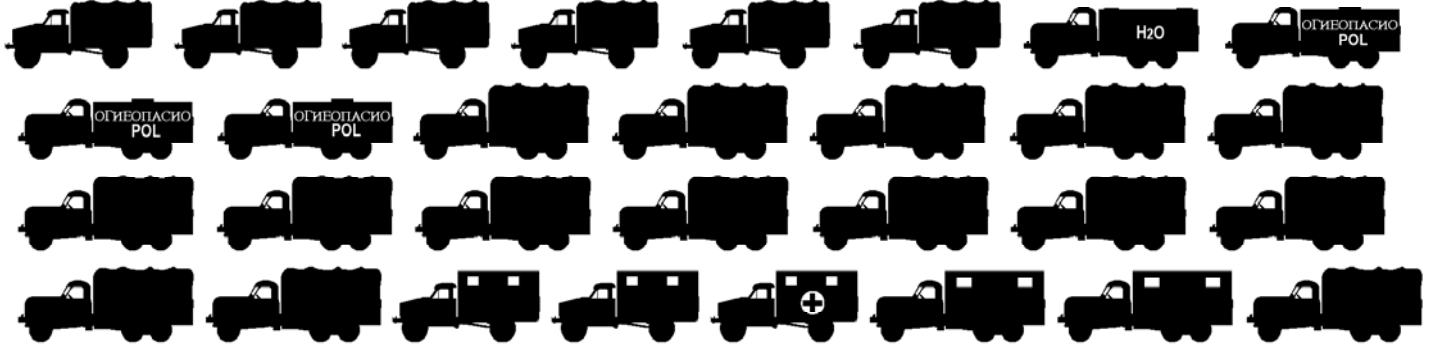
